

You are required to record a minimum of three interviews, each one of which must be a minimum of 20 minutes, but preferably 30 – 60 minutes. These interviews must be recorded in or converted to a format that is easily accessible by any CD player or computer (e.g. .wav, .MP3, MP4). All of your interviews must be duplicated and burned onto disc and submitted to the instructor (please do not turn in your original recordings). You will also be required to burn at least one interview to disc and bring it to class for in-class peer discussion and collaboration for analysis on March 3rd.

In addition, you must transcribe the interview(s) you bring for in-class work on March 3 (you do not need to transcribe all the interviews you turn in to the instructor, only those used in-class).
