



## Making History, Doing Law: Regional Politics and Government in Europe

A New Course Offering for Fall 2009:

*Making History, Doing Law* is a cross-listed course in Anthropology and the Center for European Studies. The course will focus on governance in Europe nation states and the European Union. The first half of the course will look at the last decade in the UK and the empowerment of governments in Wales, Scotland, and Northern Ireland, as well as the emerging relations among the regions and the UK Government in London.

The second half of the course will look at (1) the relations of the regions and the UK with the European Union; and (2) regional politics in other European states. If you are interested in the cultural politics of law, democracy, and governance in Europe, or if you want to learn more about nationhood, identity, and heritage in the developing EU, then this interdisciplinary course will be of interest to you.
